Inadvertent instrument meteorological conditions (IIMC) continue to be one of the leading lethal threats to helicopter operators. Despite advances in aircraft and avionics, we suffer IIMC-related fatalities year after year. This session will look at the unique aspects of IIMC, how it differs from planned entry into IMC, and why it continues to claim so many lives. IIMC survival methods based on the safety management system approach, including training, crew resource management, policy suggestions, and flying techniques, will be discussed.
