The meeting will be held at the Terminal Administrative Conference Room located on the 2nd floor. Once inside the Terminal, proceed upstairs to the Conference Room.

Flying-In - Set your GPS to **KBRO** and select "*Direct-To, Enter, Enter*". Communicate with Valley Approach and *avoid the TFRs*; Once you are on the ground, ask to Park at one of the *FBOs*.

Note – FBOs are within walking distance of the Terminal Building.

Driving-In - From IH-69E, Exit East onto Boca Chica Blvd. Turn Right (SouthEast) on Billy Mitchell Blvd. This will take you to the Airport Terminal Parking.

Walking-In - Yeah; Like a pilot is going to walk that far! Probably NOT! You may want to try a Taxi or Ride-Share.
